Three coal miners received burns after coal dust ignited about 10:50 a.m. Tuesday at North Antelope Rochelle mine.

The men were transported from Campbell County Memorial Hospital to a burn center, in Greeley, Colo., where they are being treated for second- and third-degree burns.

The coal dust ignited at a coal truck and crusher dump when a bearing was being changed on a chain conveyor. The bottom hopper or crusher doors had to

be opened to access the conveyor, which allowed coal dust from a coal slide in the hopper to engulf the area, the U.S. Mine Safety and Health Administration reported.

The dust was ignited by hot bearing embers and a weed burner used to heat the bearing race, said MSHA, which is investigating the incident.

MSHA doesn't release names of injured victims, said MSHA spokeswoman Amy Louviere. She deferred to MSHA's statement and confirmed that three employees were involved in a coal dust ignition incident.

Charlene Murdock, spokeswoman for Peabody, the St. Louis-based company that operates the mine, referred to MSHA's statement and confirmed that three employees were involved in a coal dust ignition incident.

Officials from the Campbell County Memorial Hospital couldn't be reached before deadline for more information on the victims.

North Antelope Rochelle Mine is America's largest mine, according to Peabody.

It is the second accident in the Powder River Basin so far this year. On Aug. 16 Jacob Dowdy, 24, suffered fatal injuries when an electric shovel lost propel capabilities at Black Thunder mine and rolled backward down the grade, crushing two Ford F350 flat bed utility pickup trucks. The driver of the second truck was taken to the hospital.

MSHA is still investigating that case.

Coal dust ignited, hurting three at North Antelope Rochelle

Three coal miners received burns after coal dust ignited about 10:50 a.m. Tuesday at North Antelope Rochelle mine.

The men were transported from Campbell County Memorial Hospital to a burn center, in Greeley, Colo., where they are being treated for second- and third-degree burns.

The coal dust ignited at a coal truck and crusher dump when a bearing was being changed on a chain conveyor. The bottom hopper or crusher doors had to be opened to access the conveyor, which allowed coal dust from a coal slide in the hopper to engulf the area, the U.S. Mine Safety and Health Administration reported.

The dust was ignited by hot bearing embers and a weed burner used to heat the bearing race, said MSHA, which is investigating the incident.

MSHA doesn't release names of injured victims, said MSHA spokeswoman Amy Louviere. She deferred to the company operating the mine for information about the victims.

Charlene Murdock, spokeswoman for Peabody, the St. Louis-based company that operates the mine, referred to MSHA's statement and confirmed that three employees were involved in a coal dust ignition incident.

Officials from the Campbell County Memorial Hospital couldn't be reached before deadline for more information on the victims.

North Antelope Rochelle Mine is America's largest mine, according to Peabody.

It is the second accident in the Powder River Basin so far this year. On Aug. 16 Jacob Dowdy, 24, suffered fatal injuries when an electric shovel lost propel capabilities at Black Thunder mine and rolled backward down the grade, crushing two Ford F350 flat bed utility pickup trucks. The driver of the second truck was taken to the hospital.

MSHA is still investigating that case.

What is a Makerspace? Creativity in the Library

I first heard of makerspaces when, as I sat in my office, a colleague called me over to see if I wanted to join a webinar on makerspaces. Listening over her shoulder, I heard phrases like DIY, and tools kept popping up. Not the usual web-based tools talked about in webinars, physical tools... y'know, wrenches and pliers? Real tools. I've always seen libraries as community centers for people to gather and work together, but this? It stretched my imagination.

When most people think of libraries, they naturally think books. Anyone working in a library today, however, knows that we are so much more than just books. Libraries are places of community engagement. Recently many libraries have begun to develop spaces for design and activities that both teach and empower patrons. The learning in these spaces varies wildly--from home bicycle repair, to using 3D printers, to building model airplanes. Fittingly, they are called makerspaces.

Makerspaces have evolved from hackerspaces and [Maker Faires](#). Defining a makerspace can be somewhat difficult due to the differences among spaces and activities, but the emphasis is on creating with technology. STEM education (science, technology, engineering, math) has been quick to embrace these spaces and technologies, but it is important to stress that makerspaces are not for STEM activities only. Jeff Sturges of Detroit's [Mt. Elliott Makerspace](#) said in ALA TechSource's December 3 makerspace webinar, "Beyond engineering and STEM, this is about creating creative people." He's absolutely right. The maker movement in libraries is about teaching our patrons to think for themselves, to think creatively, and to look for do-it-yourself solutions before running off to the store. In short, a makerspace is a place where people come together to create with technology.

So who uses makerspaces? Anyone! Already libraries of all types have found a way to create makerspaces. Most of these early makerspaces are in public libraries, each with a different focus, some working only with children, and others with adults. Academic libraries also are developing makerspaces, as are school libraries. Early experiences show that the potential users of makerspaces are not limited to a specific demographic. If you have patrons and you're looking for a unique method of outreach, a makerspace might be the course for you.

The United States has a long history of activists seeking social, political, economic, and other changes to America—along with a history of other activists trying to prevent such changes. American activism covered a wide range of causes and utilized many different forms of activism.

American sociopolitical activism became especially prominent during the period of societal upheaval which began during the 1950s. The African American civil rights movement led the way, soon followed by a substantial anti-war movement opposing American involvement in the Vietnam War, and later by vigorous activism involving women's issues, gay rights, and other causes.

The United States remains a land of nearly constant change, and activists play a significant role in the ongoing evolution of American democracy. It seems likely that Americans will remain enthusiastic activists in the future.

Women's Activism

Activism for women's issues in the United States has a very long history, with some notable successes achieved along the way, such as the right to vote achieved in 1920—but many important issues remained unresolved. The Equal Rights Amendment was first proposed in 1923, but did not pass Congress until 1972, and eventually failed when the ratification deadline expired in 1982. Another major issue for women involves the ongoing struggle between “pro-choice” and “anti-abortion” advocates. Substantial activism on these important issues continues today.

Some of us brought devices to write on, to which she informed us we would be writing 'old school' and passed out traditional marble composition books. A main focus of the workshop was for us each to be able to freely say, "I am a writer." I really needed to hear myself say that after pretty much hitting the creativity wall this summer. And, as a reminder that we are indeed writers, she gave us name plates for our desks. Now I have to live up to this job description.

I've seldom used writing prompts, but I found out in this class how much fun and helpful prompts can be. From listening to music, to improv from each others story lines or from provided text, to looking at beautiful artwork for inspiration, I opened the door for several new plots I'm excited to explore. Not to mention a fresh and new attitude on writing.

"I learned that you should feel when writing, not like Lord Byron on a mountain top, but like a child stringing beads in kindergarten- happy and absorbed and quietly putting one bead on after another."

The **National Road** (**Cumberland Road**) was the first major improved highway in the United States to be built by the federal government. The approximately 620-mile (1,000 km) long National Road provided a connection between the Potomac and Ohio Rivers and a gateway to the West for thousands of settlers. When rebuilt in the 1830s, the Cumberland Road became the first road in the U.S. to use the new macadam road surfacing.^[1]

Construction began heading west in 1811 at Cumberland, Maryland, on the Potomac River.^[2] It crossed the Allegheny Mountains and southwestern Pennsylvania, reaching Wheeling, Virginia (now West Virginia), on the Ohio River in 1818. Plans were made to continue through St. Louis, at confluence of the Mississippi and Missouri Rivers, and to Jefferson City upstream on the Missouri. Following the panic of 1837, however, funding ran dry and construction was stopped at Vandalia, Illinois, after crossing the states of Ohio and Indiana.

Beyond the National Road's eastern terminus at Cumberland and toward the Atlantic coast, a series of private turnpikes were completed in 1824, connecting the National Road (Pike) with Baltimore, Maryland and its port on Chesapeake Bay; these feeder routes formed what is referred to as an

The first cries for a "national road" were heard before the American nation. These calls for a road to the west came as early as the 1740s and say much about the early west. For instance, the "west" was viewed roughly as those lands which lay between the Alleghenies and Ohio River. And to many, the road was not an end unto itself. Due to the perceived superiority of water travel, the proposed road was seen primarily as a portage between waterways.

Several groups lobbied for a road or route to the west. The few western settlers themselves wished for an avenue to make it easier to market their goods and buy essential supplies in return.

Land speculators realized the importance of an infrastructure in the west. Members of the first Ohio Company, a group that included a young George Washington, saw the value of the road. The company went so far as to hire Christopher Gist and Thomas Cresap to

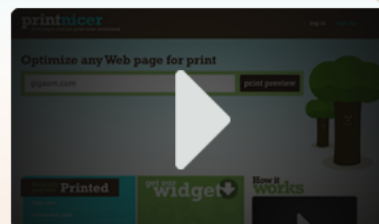

Every year, the company makes only one new model, a phone that represents Apple's platonic ideal—the one phone it thinks everybody ought to have. Apple usually sells the new phone for around \$650, and wireless carriers sell it to customers for \$199 with a two-year plan. To hedge its bets against low-priced competitors, Apple also keeps selling its previous models, reducing the price of each by \$100. Last year, when Apple unveiled the iPhone 5, it kept selling 2011's iPhone 4S for \$550 (\$99 with a contract), and the 2010 iPhone 4 sold for \$450 (free with a contract).

The advantage of this strategy is clear. Unlike its competitors, which make dozens of phones every year, Apple can focus its design and manufacturing energies on a single new model, and it can push customers to purchase its highest-end, highest-margin device. But the downside is clear, too. The iPhone is Apple's biggest business, accounting for two-thirds of its profits. By releasing only one new phone every year, Apple keeps putting more and more of its eggs in a single basket. What if that basket has a buggy antenna? What if it doesn't seem like much of an upgrade? What if its screen isn't big enough for some customers? What if it's just too expensive?

This year was supposed to be different. For months now, analysts have speculated that Apple would finally do what many observers (including yours truly) have long called on it to do—to diversify its iPhone lineup. The logic seemed obvious. Samsung, Apple's fiercest rival, has been cleaning up in developing markets like India and China by offering models that cater to every market niche, from the low end to the high end. By making a new phone that sold for around \$300 to \$400 without a carrier subsidy—which is how many people in developing markets buy phones—Apple would be able to compete for price-conscious phone buyers, creating a whole new class of iPhone users who currently can't afford Apple's shiny baubles.

But today, Apple whiffed. At the company's headquarters in Cupertino,

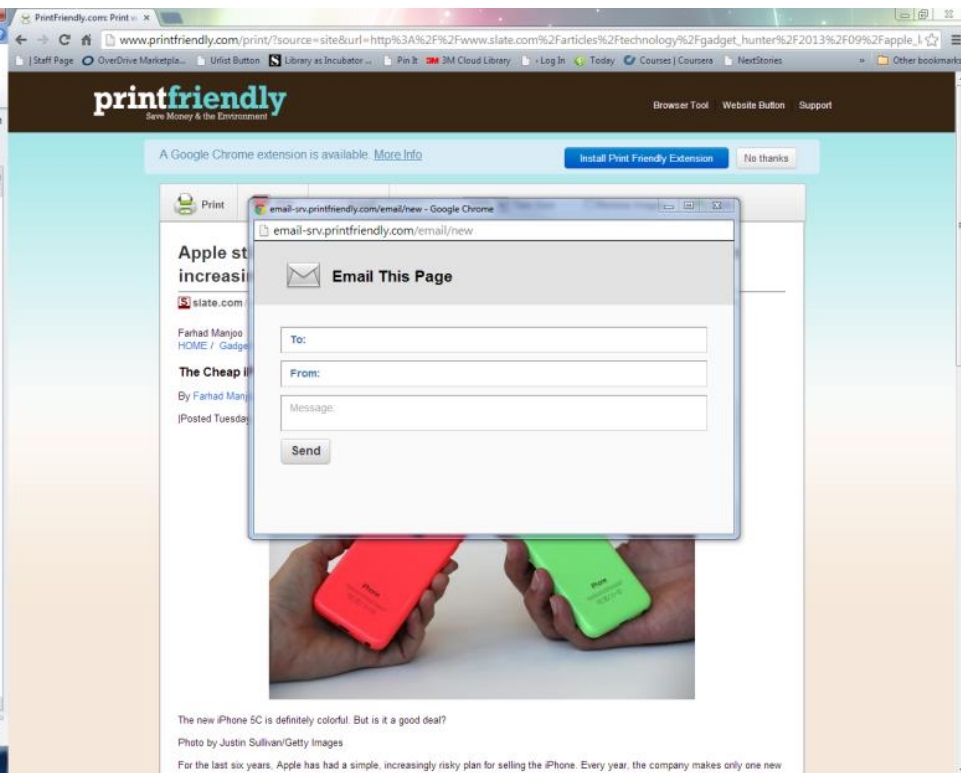
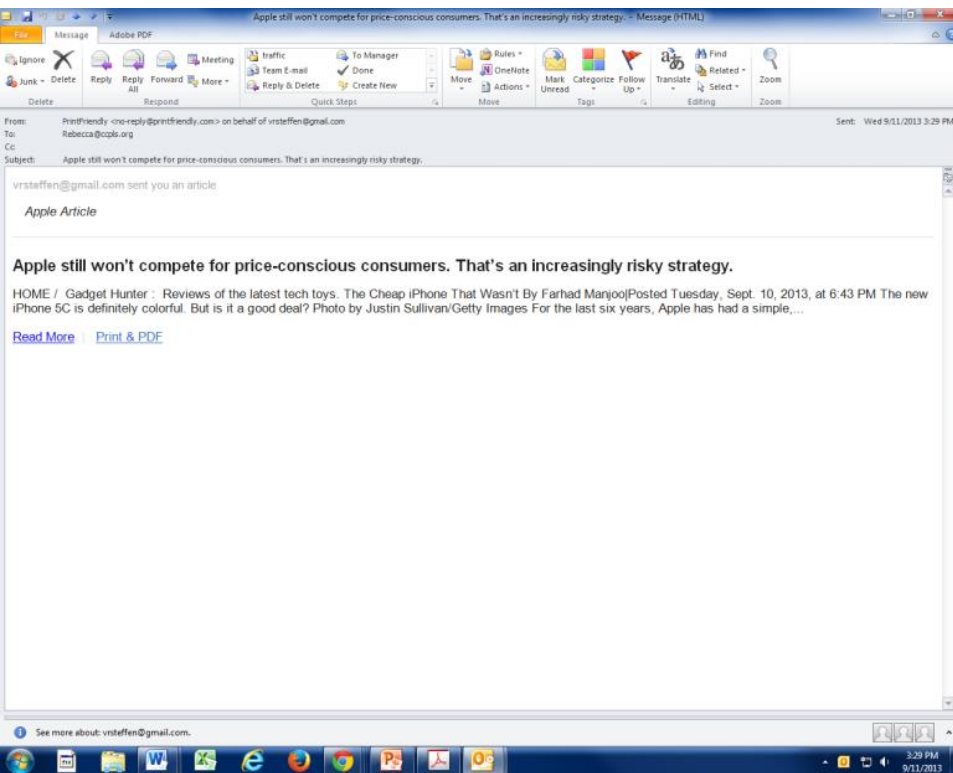
